

T-shirt Design Contest

The Joey O' Bocce Classic for Cystic Fibrosis is now accepting entries for their t-shirt design contest.

The Joey O' Bocce Classic tournament is a local fundraising event that raises money and awareness for Cystic Fibrosis research and care, with the proceeds going to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. <https://joeyobocceclassic.org/> Cystic Fibrosis is a progressive genetic disease that affects the lungs and the ability to breathe. Every year, teams compete in a bocce tournament at Cardinal Gibbons, where Joey O'Connell, the namesake and founder of the charity event, went to High School. Bocce is an Italian game similar to lawn bowling but played on a shorter, narrower green. This year, the event is scheduled for April 26th.



Get out your computers, markers or colored pencils and start creating! T-shirt design entries should be created in color on white paper. Entry designs must be limited to no more than 3 colors, so that screen printing costs are economical. Do not color the background of your design. That will be the color of the t-shirt. Everything that needs to be printed counts as a color. Even black and white count as colors if they are to be printed on the shirt. All entries should be submitted by February 27th.
